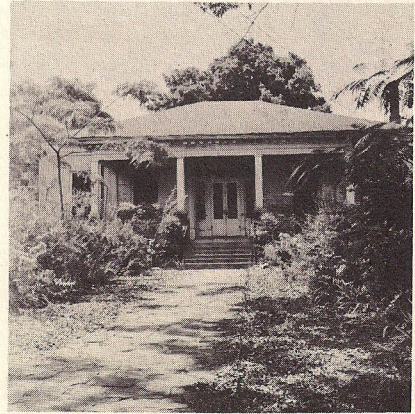


SOME HISTORIC HOMES IN LITTLE ROCK



Trapnall Hall. 432 East Capitol Avenue. Built by Frederick Trapnall in 1843. (See Vol. III, p. 59, P. C. H. R.)



Curran Hall. 615 East Capitol. Built in 1843. Named for James M. Curran, an early owner. (See Vol. III, p. 59, P. C. H. R.)



Home of Absalom Fowler. 503 East 6th St. Built about 1840. Now used by St. Andrews School. (See Vol. V. p. 17, P.C.H.R.)



Home of William E. Woodruff. Built about 1853 or 1854. 1017 East 8th Street. Now used as an apartment house.
