Benjamin lived in Sevier Co. TN. The courthouse burned and records were lost.

Benjamin went to Whitfield Co. GA in 1860, lived there 9 yrs. Then settled in Scott Co. Ark. in 1869, Hickman township. Farmer, earnest Christian, Democrat. He was living in Blansett Township when his grandson, William Henry Brown went out to stay with him in 1883-84. He was on the school board of his district.. The article on Samuel C. Brown tells about Benjamin. We found a list in Nancy C. Brown's Bible that gave a list of all of Benjamin's family in chronological order . July , 2008., Erwin, TN.

A Scott Co. list of descendants of Benjamin doesn't

mention Nancy C. Brown. I wonder if the tensions of the Civil War caused a rift in the family? Nancy's husband and his family were strongly for the Union and her husband and his brother died in the Union Army. Samuel fought in the Confederacy in Co.K 5<sup>th</sup> Tenn. Cavalry, later changed to 1st Tenn. Cavalry. He was captured defending Knoxville. Her cousin David Cusick was also confederate.

Whitfield Co. is near Dalton,GA. Walker Co. is mentioned in some records. Walker is just west of Whitfield Co. Both are in far NW Georgia, not too far from Chattanooga. Census records from ARK show the children of Benjamin by Elizabeth were born in Whitfield Co. GA.

Martha Cusick's brothers: Benjamin, Plover, William, David.
