George R. 22

C.G. Crump owned 32 acres improved and 48 acres unimproved woodland worth \$400. He had farming tools worth \$75 and livestock valued at \$200. He had spent \$79 on his fences and paid \$50 in wages for farm labor. Estimated farm production for 1879 was \$500. He had 2 horses, 4 milch cows and 5 other cattle. 3 calves were dropped during the preceding year. He had purchased 4 head of cattle, sold 4 and slaughtered 1. 50 pounds of butter had been churned on his farm. He had 10 barnyard and 50 other poultry which provided 30 dozen eggs. 14 acres produced 200 bushels of Indian Corn, 15 acres produced 12 bales of cotton and 1 acre of sorghum produced 80 gallons of sorghum.

Margaret Ann Crump Biography

This note came with the document (author unknown to me):

Individual History: Presumably, Margaret Ann Crump died in Ada, Pontotoc County, Oklahoma. Her brief written account indicates that she moved 'to Ada in 1919 where I have lived ever since in the same house.' The account itself is undated but is attached to the back of Marion Laffoyette Hunt's personal recollections, which are dated 7 March 1957 - only four years prior to Margarets death. The notes of Margaret appear as an addendum to Marion Laffoyette Hunts memorandum and appear to be in the same typing style. One could presume that MLH typed MAC's recollections concurrently with his own, which would establish that MAC's recollections are dated from circa March 1957.

I was born February 27, 1882. Father's name Gibbin Crump. Mother Harriet Corbel Crump. My father died when I was 8 years old. To this union was born 8 children: David, Betty, Dan, Ruth, Nove, Jord, Margaret and Artie. David died when young. Betty married Bob Whisenant. Dan married Florella Cates. Ruth married Marion Hunt. Nove married Minnie Brown. Margaret married James W. Ragland and Artie married Marshall Ragland. I had two half-sisters by my mother's first marriage to a Mr. Sisk. They were Mary Jane, who married William Sheppard and Rhoda, that married Hugh Bandy, and a Mr. Hall. I had two half-brothers and one half sister by my father's former marriage. George, who never married. John married Nan Cates and Caroline married to a Jim Winford and a Mr. Cates. John and Nan's children were: Dicie, Bonnie, Bob, Sam, Leroy, Bently, and Frank. Caroline and Jim Winford's children were Evie and Charlie. Mary Jane and William Sheppard's children were: Gus, Bernice, Tom, Florence and Bessie. George who never married, no children. David died when young. Betty and Bob Whisenants children were: Frank, Ettie, Mary, Emmitt, Isabell, Hattie, Foxie and Ola. Dan and Florella Cates Crumps children were: Leven, Abe, John, Matthew, Dorothy and Hiram. Ruth and Marion Hunt's children were: Zora, Ezra, Alice, Virgil, Bill, Sam, Clarence, Edna and Effie. Nove and Minnie Brown Crump's children were Wilma, Artie and Bessie. Jord Crump never

married, no children. Margaret and James Ragland had one child, James. Artie and Marshall Ragland's children were: Bertha, Katie, Othar, Hobert, Zora and Ruth. I was born in Boles county, Arkansas. My father was almost blind and I would walk with him to the field and back. We went to church in a log house at Buffalo school house. After my father died, we moved to Texas where I went to school and church at Charity and it was a plank building. To the best of my recollection, our first minister was a Rev. Mankin at Arkansas. My mother then married a Mr. Joseph W. Leach, then a little later we came to Oklahoma. Before moving the whole family here to Oklahoma, I spent a while with sister Ruth and Marion. This was a very thinly settled country. No recreation or anything at first. I must say to be honest, I didn't like this country whatever. When our family moved here at about the age of 15, I was converted at Oakman and baptized by a Rev. Ison who in the year 1900 married me to James Ragland. To our union was born one child, James. We lived at Oakman, Ada, Stonewall, Blanchard, back to Oakman, then to Ada in 1919 where I have lived ever since in the same house.

Well, I knew I'd done something on Melinda before but couldn't find it. It's on page 4 of the Park Township book. If you don't have that book, let me know and I'll send the story. This was one of my "theories" - Joseph Henry Taylor's 2nd wife was listed in everything I found as Melinda McRay but I was sure she was Melinda Crump who married John McVey in Sevier Co 1856. I believe I even got the marriage license of Joseph Henry Taylor to Melinda from Yell Co. Clerk's office in an effort to prove she was McVey instead of McRay, but sure enough it said McRay. I still think it was McVey. She was listed on the 1870 Yell Co census as McDay so evidently there was some problem understanding/writing the name. Taylor descendants say Melinda died in 1903 but I never could find out where. - Delaine Edwards

This couple is first found in Yell County Census of Dutchess Creek Twp # 14/14 with four children. Joseph "Henry" Taylor was born May 18, 1818 in North Carolina and died May 7, 1892 in Scott County, Arkansas, buried Dooley Cemetery. This couple is found in the 1860 Scott County census of Park Twp # 19/19 listed as Henry at age 42 with wife and six children. He is a farmer with \$2500/595 in property. It is unknown why Elizabeth and Henry Taylor moved the Parks area rather than the Dutch Creek area, where the rest of the family settled. Henry is found as a widower in the 1870 census of Park Twp PO Waldron #48/48 with no wife, but with 6 children. He married (2) Melinda Crump May 26, 1872 in Yell County, Arkansas.
